BRIDGE HISTORY/PURPOSE:

- ★ Location: Sanjian County, China
- ★ The bridge was in the Mio, Zhuang, Dong, and Yao dynasty.
- \star It is said to be a crystal of the Dong people's wisdom.
- ★ The bridge is 64.4 meters long, 3.4 meters wide and 10.6 meters high.
- ★ Constructed with wood and stones, the surface of the bridge is paved with wooden boards and both sides are inlayed with railings.
- ★ The bridge is a combination of bridge, corridor, veranda and Chinese pavilion.

BRIDGE DESIGN:



- ★ Constructed with wood and stones, the surface of the bridge is paved with wooden boards and both sides are inlayed with railings.

- ★ What's more surprising is that Chengyang Wind and Rain Bridge was built without any nails or rivets. Instead, talented Dong people dove-tailed many pieces of wood. Though several decades old, the bridge is still very sturdy and looks like a brilliant rainbow crossing over the river.
- ★ The overall structure is a combination of wooden corridors lined with benches, verandas and Chinese pavilions which rest on one or several stone or concrete piers.
